CATARACT LAKE LOOP (LOWER) - FDT 57

Difficulty: EASY **Trail Use:** Heavy

Length: 2.0 miles around the loop

Elevation: Start at 8,652 feet and ends at 8,662 feet (highest point 8,770 feet)

Elevation Gain: +136 feet - 126 feet = +10 feet
Open To: HIKING, X-C SKIING, SNOWSHOEING

Access:

- From I-70 take Exit 205, Silverthorne / Dillon, and travel north on HWY 9.
- Travel 16 miles north on HWY 9. Just after mile marker 118 turn left onto Heeney Road (County Rd 30).
- Follow Heeney Road for 5.3 miles and turn left onto Cataract Creek Road (County Rd 1725).
- Continue for 2.5 miles to the Lower Cataract Trailhead and parking area at the end of the road. Please do not block the gate.

Trail Highlights:

- This is a loop trail which can be hiked in either direction. There are wonderful views of the lake and surrounding mountains.
- A great area for fishing, hiking and picnicking.
- An abundance of wildflowers can be seen from late June through mid July.
- There isn't a trail to the base of the waterfall. Therefore, hiking to the waterfall is strongly discouraged due to slippery and steep terrain.

Eagles Nest Wilderness Regulations:

- Motor vehicles, mountain bikes and motorized equipment are prohibited.
- DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES IN THE EAGLES NEST WILDERNESS.
- Group size is limited to 15 people.
- Camping is prohibited within 1/4 mile of Lower Cataract Lake.
- Campfires are prohibited at Lower Cataract Lake.
