SWAN VALLEY RECREATION AREA

Difficulty: MODERATE TO MORE DIFFICULT

Trail Use: Moderate

Length: Varies depending on trail

Elevation Gain: Varies depending on trail

Open In Summer To: HIKING, HORSE, MTN. BIKING, 4X4, ATV, MOTORCYCLE

Open In Winter To: X-C SKIING, SNOWSHOEING, SNOWMOBILING

Access:

- From I-70 take Exit 203, Frisco / Breckenridge, and travel south on HWY 9 toward Breckenridge.
- After approximately 6.7 miles turn left onto Tiger Road (CR 6).
- Travel east on Tiger Road for approximately 4.7 miles to the old Tiger Townsite, this is the winter parking area. You can also park here during the summer.

- From the North Fork of the Swan you can ride to the top of Wise Mountain, elevation 12,052 feet..
- From the Middle Fork of the Swan mountain you can travel to the top of the Continental Divide, elevation 12,624 feet, near Sheep Mountain.
- From the South Fork of the Swan you can travel to the top of the Continental Divide at Georgia Pass, elevation 11,585 feet.

- **STAY ON DESIGNATED ROADS TO PREVENT RESOURCE DAMAGE.**
- A large portion of this area is above timberline. For this reason, be sure to check the weather forecast and choose a clear day for your trip.
- Private snowmobile guides also run their tours in this area. Some of their trails may be groomed.
- Please to protect this resource. The alpine tundra is very fragile, stay on designated routes.
